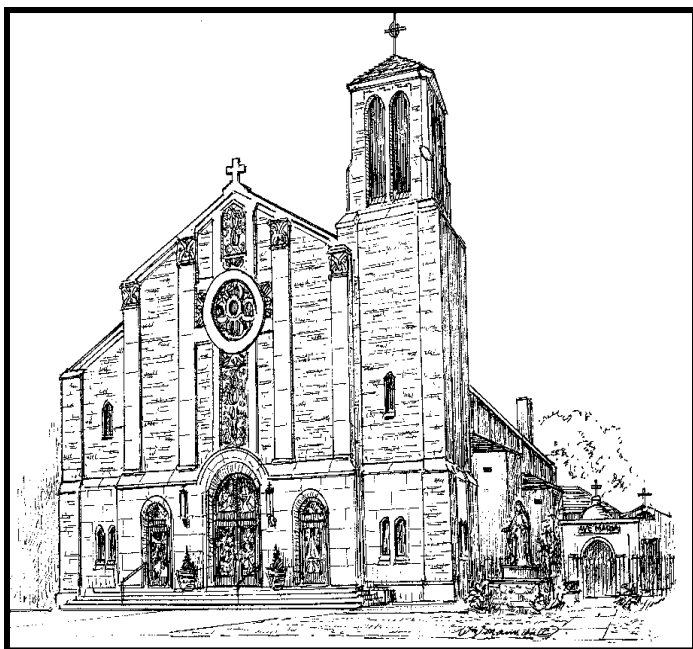

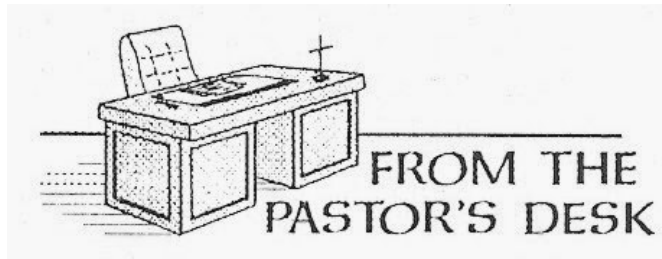

In this Sunday's gospel passage taken from the Gospel of Luke we hear about Jesus appearance to his apostles in the upper room. They are all overjoyed but also not sure if what they are seeing is actually real. Then Jesus not only shows them the nail marks in his hands and feet, he invites them to touch him, to see for themselves that he is physically there and not some sort of ghost. He then says something that I have always found curious, he asks if they have anything to eat. He does this to reinforce the fact that he has physically risen from the dead. He then goes on to open up scripture to them and opening up their minds all the while he is seated at the table eating. This is an example for each one of us as disciples of Christ. We are called to find moments in which we can share our faith with others and that isn't always preaching from a pulpit or arguing. Here Jesus could have stood in front of them, like a teacher does, and given a lecture but no he sits at table with them and in that casual environment brings his disciples to the fullness of Truth. May we too take those same opportunity to bring other to the Truth of our faith always through charity.



En el pasaje del evangelio de este domingo tomado del evangelio de Lucas, escuchamos acerca de la aparición de Jesús a sus apóstoles en el aposento alto. Todos están encantados, pero tampoco están seguros de si lo que ven es realmente real. Entonces Jesús no solo les muestra las marcas de los clavos en sus manos y pies, los invita a tocarlo, a ver por sí mismos que él está físicamente allí y no una especie de fantasma. Luego dice algo que siempre me ha parecido curioso, pregunta si tienen algo de comer. Hace esto para reforzar el hecho de que físicamente se ha levantado de entre los muertos. Luego continúa abriéndoles las Escrituras y abriéndoles la mente todo el tiempo mientras está sentado a la mesa comiendo. Este es un ejemplo para cada uno de nosotros como discípulos de Cristo. Estamos llamados a encontrar momentos en los que podamos compartir nuestra fe con los demás y eso no siempre es predicar desde un púlpito o discutir. Aquí Jesús podría haberse parado frente a ellos, como lo hace un maestro, y dar una conferencia, pero no, se sienta a la mesa con ellos y en ese ambiente informal lleva a sus discípulos a la plenitud de la Verdad. Que también nosotros aprovechemos esa misma oportunidad para llevar a otros a la Verdad de nuestra fe siempre a través de la caridad.



Nel brano dell' evangelio di questa domenica tratto di Luca sentiamo parlare dell'apparizione di Gesù ai suoi apostoli nel cenacolo. Sono tutti felicissimi, ma non sono nemmeno sicuri che ciò che vedono sia effettivamente reale. Quindi Gesù non solo mostra loro i segni dei chiodi sulle mani e sui piedi, ma li invita a toccarlo, per vedere di persona che è fisicamente lì e non una sorta di fantasma. Poi dice qualcosa che ho sempre trovato curioso, chiede se hanno qualcosa da mangiare. Lo fa per rafforzare il fatto che è risorto fisicamente dai morti. Poi continua ad aprire loro le Scritture e ad aprire le loro menti per tutto il tempo che è seduto a tavola a mangiare. Questo è un esempio per ognuno di noi come discepoli di Cristo. Siamo chiamati a trovare momenti in cui possiamo condividere la nostra fede con gli altri e questo non è sempre predicare dal pulpito o litigare. Qui Gesù avrebbe potuto stare di fronte a loro, come fa un insegnante, e tenere una conferenza ma non si siede a tavola con loro e in quell'ambiente informale porta i suoi discepoli alla pienezza della Verità. Cogliamo anche noi questa stessa opportunità per portare gli altri alla Verità della nostra fede sempre attraverso la carità.
