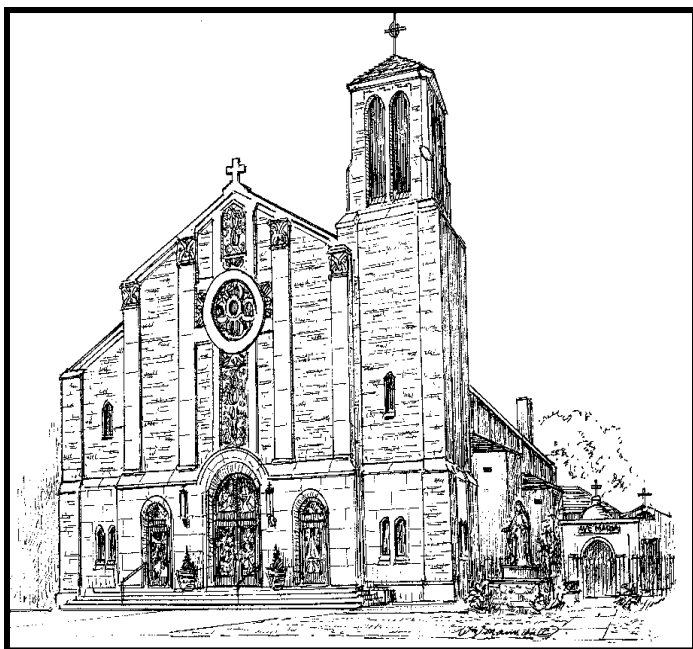

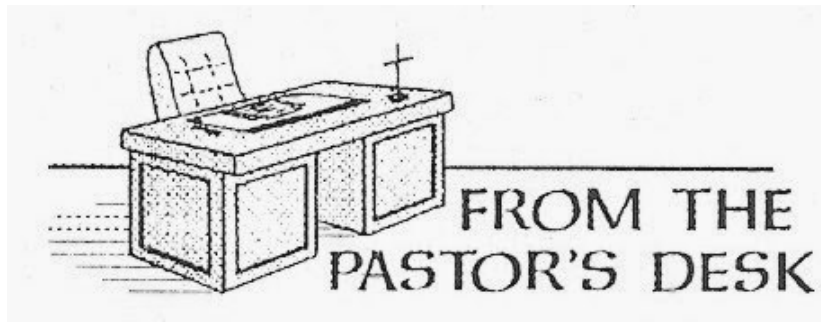

In this Sunday's gospel we hear John complaining to the Lord about people who are driving out evil spirits in the name of the Lord. John's biggest problem is that these people are not part of the inner circle of the Lord. We can easily look at this passage and only focus on John's perceived self-righteous attitude, but there is a much more important lesson that we find when we take the whole passage into account. Our Lord is teaching his disciples and each one of us to avoid scandal which causes others to sin. The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines scandal as "Scandal is an attitude or behavior which leads another to do evil. The person who gives scandal becomes his neighbor's tempter... he may even draw his brother into spiritual death. Scandal is a grave offense if by deed or omission another is deliberately led into a grave offense." Many of the debates today about which politicians should and shouldn't receive communion has to do with the grave sin of scandal. Self-professed practicing catholic politicians who publicly support and defend morally grave sin can truly be a cause of scandal. Scandal for their position but also lead other Catholics into the thought that this is ok and as a result causing someone else to sin as well. Let us pray to the Lord that we may be able to identify scandal and avoid it for the safety of our souls and the souls of those around us.

Nel vangelo di questa domenica ascoltiamo Giovanni che si lamenta con il Signore delle persone che stanno scacciando gli spiriti maligni nel nome del Signore. Il problema più grande di Giovanni è che queste persone non fanno parte del gruppo degli amici (discepoli) del Signore. Possiamo facilmente guardare questo passaggio e concentrarci solo sull'atteggiamento ipocrita percepito di Giovanni, ma c'è una lezione molto più importante che troviamo quando prendiamo in considerazione l'intero passaggio. Nostro Signore sta insegnando ai suoi discepoli e a ciascuno di noi ad evitare lo scandalo che fa peccare gli altri. Il Catechismo della Chiesa Cattolica definisce lo scandalo come "Lo scandalo è un atteggiamento o un comportamento che porta un altro a fare il male. Chi dà scandalo diventa tentatore del prossimo... può anche portare il fratello alla morte spirituale. Lo scandalo è un reato grave se con un atto o un'omissione un altro è deliberatamente portato a commettere un reato grave". Molti dei dibattiti odierni su quali politici dovrebbero e non dovrebbero ricevere la comunione hanno a che fare con il grave peccato dello scandalo. I politici cattolici praticanti sedicenti che pubblicamente sostengono e difendono il peccato moralmente grave possono davvero essere motivo di scandalo. Scandalo per la loro posizione, ma porta anche altri cattolici a pensare che questo sia ok e di conseguenza fa peccare anche qualcun altro. Preghiamo il Signore che possiamo essere in grado di identificare lo scandalo ed evitarlo per la sicurezza delle nostre anime e delle anime di chi ci circonda.

En el evangelio de este domingo escuchamos a Juan quejándose con el Señor acerca de las personas que están expulsando los espíritus malignos en el nombre del Señor. El mayor problema de John es que estas personas no forman parte del círculo íntimo del Señor. Podemos mirar fácilmente este pasaje y solo enfocarnos en la actitud de justicia propia que percibimos de Juan, pero hay una lección mucho más importante que encontramos cuando tomamos en cuenta todo el pasaje. Nuestro Señor está enseñando a sus discípulos ya cada uno de nosotros a evitar el escándalo que hace pecar a otros. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica define el escándalo como "El escándalo es una actitud o comportamiento que lleva a otro a hacer el mal. La persona que da escándalo se convierte en tentador de su vecino ... incluso puede llevar a su hermano a la muerte espiritual. El escándalo es un delito grave si por acción u omisión se induce deliberadamente a otro a cometer un delito grave ". Muchos de los debates de hoy sobre qué políticos deben y no deben comulgar tienen que ver con el grave pecado del escándalo. Los políticos católicos practicantes autoproclamados que apoyan y defienden públicamente el pecado moralmente grave pueden ser realmente una causa de escándalo. Escándalo por su posición, pero también llevó a otros católicos a pensar que esto está bien y, como resultado, hace que alguien más peque también. Oremos al Señor para que podamos identificar el escándalo y evitarlo por la seguridad de nuestras almas y las almas de los que nos rodean.

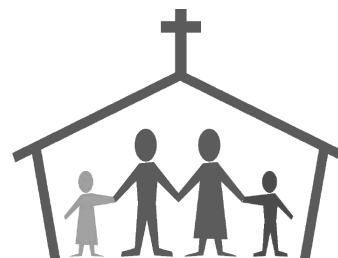
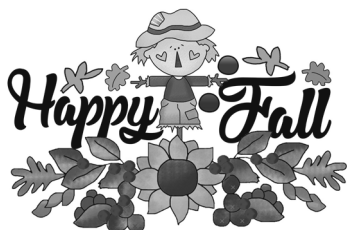
