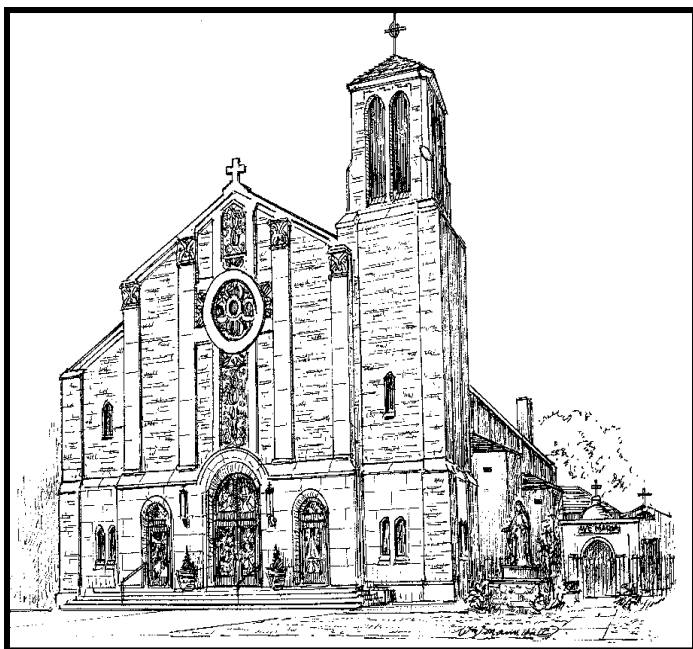

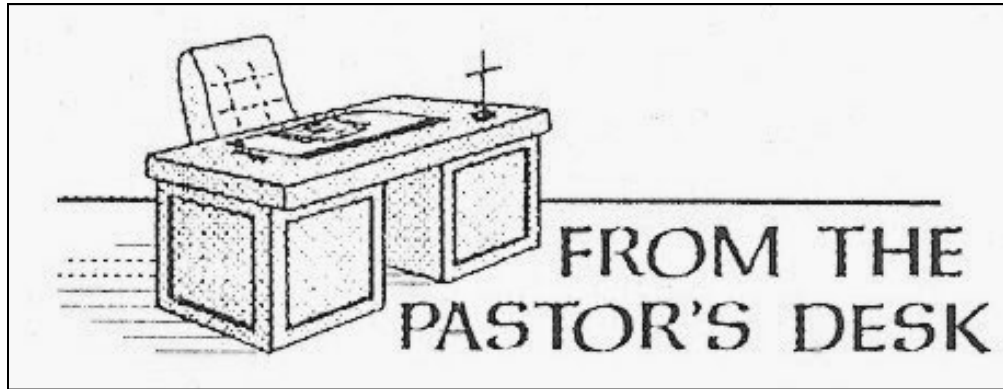

In this weekend's gospel we encounter Bartimaeus, a man born blind who spends his days on the roadside begging. He hears that Jesus is passing by and feels that this is his opportunity to seek the miracle he has longed for all of these years. He cries out to Jesus "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me!" We see here a deep faith on the part of Bartimaeus, he recognizes who Jesus is as the Son of David, meaning the Messiah King. But his faith isn't one of simple words or professions but also of action. When Jesus finally calls for him, Bartimaeus leaps up and runs to him, runs after the sound of his voice. At that point the possessions he had with him no longer matter, he left all that behind for that encounter with Jesus. His faith is one of words but also of action, it comes from a deep conviction so much so that Jesus says to him that his faith has saved him. We too can walk along the journeys of our lives blinded by sin and our brokenness. Jesus wants to heal us, he wants us to see clearly, but he needs us to put the faith we proclaim with our mouths into action. We bear true testimony to our faith not by the words we speak but by our actions. It was enough for Bartimaeus to profess his faith in Jesus, he needed to run to him for that personal encounter.

Nel Vangelo di questo fine settimana incontriamo Bartimeo, un uomo nato cieco che trascorre le sue giornate a mendicare lungo la strada. Sente che Gesù sta passando e sente che questa è la sua opportunità per cercare il miracolo che ha desiderato in tutti questi anni. Grida a Gesù: "Gesù, figlio di Davide, abbi pietà di me!" Vediamo qui una fede profonda da parte di Bartimeo, che riconosce chi è Gesù come Figlio di Davide, cioè il Messia Re. Ma la sua fede non è fatta di semplici parole o professioni, ma anche di azione. Quando finalmente Gesù lo chiama, Bartimeo balza in piedi e gli corre incontro, gli corre dietro al suono della sua voce. A quel punto i beni che aveva con sé non contano più, tutto questo lasciò per quell'incontro con Gesù. La sua è una fede di parole ma anche di azione, nasce da una convinzione profonda tanto che Gesù gli dice che la sua fede lo ha salvato. Anche noi possiamo percorrere i cammini della nostra vita accecati dal peccato e dalla nostra fragilità. Gesù vuole guarirci, vuole che vediamo chiaramente, ma ha bisogno che mettiamo in pratica la fede che annunciamo con la nostra bocca. Diamo una vera testimonianza della nostra fede non con le parole che pronunciamo, ma con le nostre azioni. Bastava che Bartimeo professasse la sua fede in Gesù, doveva correre da lui per quell'incontro personale.

En el evangelio de este fin de semana nos encontramos con Bartimeo, un ciego de nacimiento que pasa sus días en la carretera mendigando. Oye que Jesús pasa y siente que esta es su oportunidad de buscar el milagro que ha anhelado todos estos años. Grita a Jesús: "¡Jesús, Hijo de David, ten piedad de mí!" Vemos aquí una fe profunda por parte de Bartimeo, él reconoce quién es Jesús como el Hijo de David, es decir, el Mesías Rey. Pero su fe no se basa en simples palabras o profesiones, sino también en acciones. Cuando Jesús finalmente lo llama, Bartimeo se levanta de un salto y corre hacia él, corre tras el sonido de su voz. En ese momento las posesiones que tenía con él ya no importan, dejó todo eso atrás para ese encuentro con Jesús. Su fe es de palabra pero también de acción, nace de una profunda convicción tanto que Jesús le dice que su fe lo ha salvado. Nosotros también podemos caminar por los viajes de nuestras vidas cegados por el pecado y nuestro quebrantamiento. Jesús quiere sanarnos, quiere que veamos con claridad, pero necesita que pongamos en acción la fe que proclamamos con la boca. Damos verdadero testimonio de nuestra fe no por las palabras que hablamos, sino por nuestras acciones. A Bartimeo le bastaba con profesar su fe en Jesús, necesitaba correr hacia él para ese encuentro personal.
