

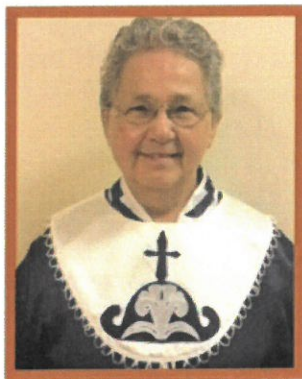

Join Bishop Gary Gordon and our invited speakers, Sister Kateri Mitchell SSA and Deacon Harry Lafond, for a day of reflection on **gratitude**.



Sister Kateri Mitchell (SSA) was born and raised on the International St. Regis Mohawk Reservation (Akwesasne) located along the St. Lawrence River/Seaway. She belongs to a matriarchal and matrilineal society of the Iroquois Confederacy, and is of the turtle clan in the Mohawk Nation. She has worked as a teacher and a school administrator; since 1982, she has been in full-time Native Ministry in various capacities in both the US and Canada

Deacon Harry Lafond (M.Ed) comes from and lives on the on the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation. He is of the Cree Nation, which occupies the territories stretching from James Bay to the Rocky Mountains. He has taught at all levels; in 2019, he was appointed Scholar of Indigenous Education at St. Thomas More College (University of Saskatchewan). He served his people as Chief of Muskeg Lake for 10 years and has been a councillor for the past 11 years. In 2020, he was ordained a Deacon in the Diocese of Prince Albert.
