**Students entering Grade 1:** Any book in the “Frog & Toad” series by Arnold Lobel

**Students entering Grade 2:** “Flat Stanley Book: His Original Adventure” by Jeff Brown

**Students entering Grade 3:** Any book in the “Judy Moody” or “Stink” series by Megan McDonald

**Students entering Grade 4:** “The Wild Robot” by Peter Brown

- A sentence about your favorite scene in the book
- A sentence with question for your character
- A sentence telling your character one thing you liked about the book
