"Did You Know" Pro-Life Campaign.... "After the abortion I started drinking. All through college, I drank, experimented with drugs, and ran from the pain. About 10 years later, I sought counseling....I was on the verge of suicide. It was at that time that I realized that the root of my problems was the abortion." (Rachel, a participant in the Rachel's Vineyard—a retreat for those who have had an abortion or have encourage someone to have one.)

It is the largest post-abortion ministry in the world and offers a safe place to renew, rebuild and redeem hearts broken by abortion, a therapy of the soul.

Rachel's Vineyard weekend retreats offer a beautiful opportunity to experience the merciful, freeing and healing love of Jesus Christ for any woman or man who has struggled with the emotional, physical or spiritual pain of a past abortion.
