Eucharistic Moment

The Aparecida document, which Pope Francis has acknowledged as one of the main authors during his time as Archbishop of Buenos Aires, teaches clearly: "We hope that legislators [and] heads of government ... will defend and protect [the dignity of human life] from the abominable crimes of abortion and euthanasia; that is their responsibility ... We must adhere to 'eucharistic coherence,' that is, be conscious that they cannot receive Holy Communion and at the same time act with deeds or words against the commandments, particularly when abortion, euthanasia, and other grave crimes against life and family are encouraged. This responsibility weighs particularly over legislators, heads of governments, and health professionals." Eucharistic coherence means that "Amen" at Holy Communion includes not only the recognition of the Real Presence but also a communion bound together by embracing and living Christ's entire teaching handed down to us through the Church.
