**A new Lighthouse** Talks CD is available in the entry of the churches. It is titled "Were The Gospels Anonymous?" by Dr. Brant Pitre. Were the gospels really written by Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John or are the authors anonymous? Did the stories come to us through some sort of "telephone game" or by way of eye witnesses? It is vital to address the debate over anonymous gospels. If we don't know who wrote the gospels, then how reliable are the stories written about Jesus? Can we look at the gospels as legitimate historical sources for the life, the death and the resurrection of Jesus? Stop and pick one up. Cost: \$4.

**Have various Church leaders** and theologians played down the influence of Our Lady over the 2nd half of the 20th century? Cardinal Ratzinger, later to become Pope Benedict XVI, called the 10 years following Vatican 2, "a decade without Mary". Do these statements bother you? Want to know more? If so, join me as I facilitate discussion on this topic using a new You Tube video series authored by Dr. Mark Miravalle. Dr. Miravalle is a Professor of Theology at Franciscan University of Steubenville, specializing in Mariology and Spiritual Theology. His new series, Mary Live 2.0, will discuss the full truth and mariology about Our Lady. How we went from the beautiful development of doctrine in the 1800s and early 1900s (the Age of Mary) to a minimalistic expression about Our Lady in the years leading up to Vatican 2 and during its aftermath. Our weekly discussion will take place every Sunday, beginning October 3rd, at 2:00pm, in St John's dining area. What better way to enter October, the Month of the Most Holy Rosary. Bring your bibles and "Let's Be Influential for Our Lady"!
