It is easy to make a charitable gift from your IRA to one of our three parishes. The IRA Charitable Rollover is actually a "qualified charitable distribution" that can be made directly to our parishes. You can reduce your taxable income even if you don't itemize deductions! This smart giving option works well if, 1) you are at least 70 ½ years old on the date you make your gift; 2) your IRA is a traditional or ROTH; and 3) you don't exceed your personal maximum of \$100,000 per year in qualified charitable distributions. Your gift must go directly from your IRA to our parishes. If you receive the money first, then you will be taxed on it like any other distribution. Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal (Feast Day November 27th): Heaven came down to earth...Between July and December 1830, Sister Catherine, a young Seminary Sister (novice) of the Daughters of Charity, received the extraordinary favour of conversing with Our Lady on three occasions. During the second apparition, Our Lady came to Sister Catherine in two images which would later form the model for the present-day Miraculous Medal. A voice said to her, "Have a medal made according to this model. For those who wear it with confidence, there will be abundant graces." During the third apparition, the voice said to her, "These rays are the symbol of the graces that the Blessed Virgin obtains for those who ask them of her..."
