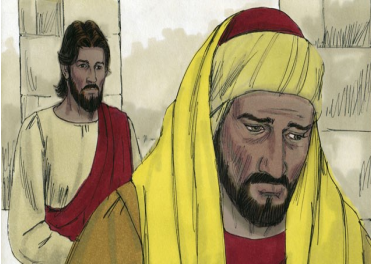

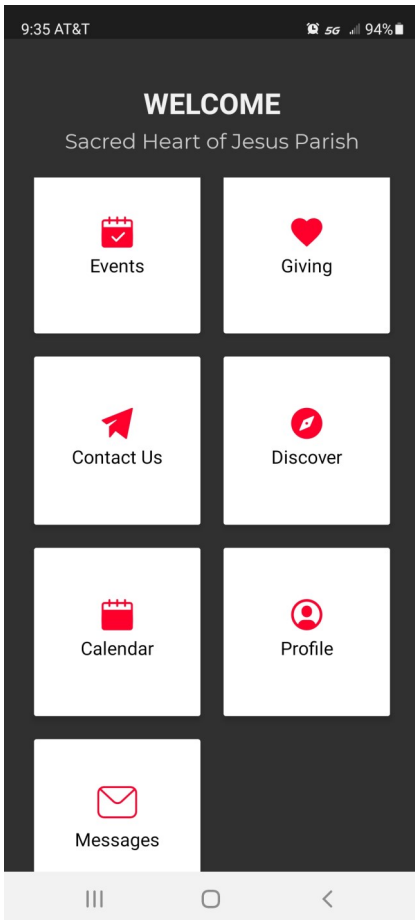


America Needs Fatima!
