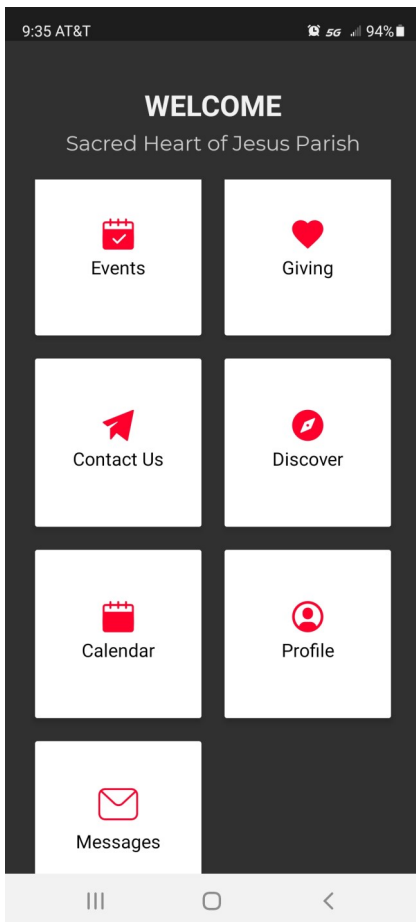


Vietnamese RCIA Announcement
