**RE: Update on COVID-19 Guidelines**

I have had a conversation with the COVID response team at the chancery and we wish to address some new developments in our response.

We are aware that the governor has lifted some restrictions on gathering, but we still see a need to be cautious about gatherings in our parishes. People should still maintain at least six feet of distance between individuals and family units and everyone attending a parish function should still wear a mask. It might be a good time to look again at your seating and gathering spaces to see how to best accommodate your community.

We are not yet ready to host less restricted events for those who have been vaccinated. We know you are getting requests, but public health officials continue to advise against large gatherings of multiple households even if everyone present is vaccinated. The logistics of proving who is fully vaccinated further complicates the issue. We hope that vaccination rates continue to climb and we will be able to start moving forward soon.

We do have some good news. Our overall guidelines are under review. Look for an update next week with new information regarding quarantines and vaccines.
