We reviewed the income and expenses with the Archdiocese on the finances for St. Mary's, prior to the Finance Meeting held Monday. Here's a brief snapshot reflecting status as of November 30th.

St. Mary's is currently \$4,907 in the red for Fiscal Year 20/21. We feel this is due to the continuation of decreased attendance and offertory income on account of the COVID-19 Pandemic. The current monthly expenses are \$ 8,034 and the monthly income is \$ 5,119. These figures include Capital Improvements of the roof repairs and gutter guards. The balance for the Building Fund for Saint Mary's as of 11/30/2020 is \$ 29,119.18.
