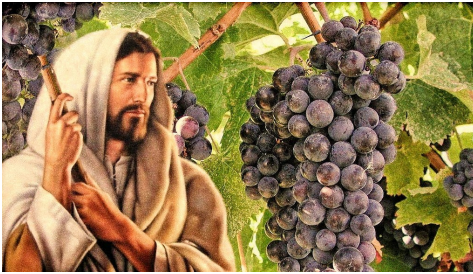

Statement from Archbishop Hartmayer on Expiration of Dispensation

On May 22, prior to the celebration of the Vigil of Pentecost, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass will expire in the Archdiocese of Atlanta.

While the general dispensation will lift, I will put into place some exceptions for certain circumstances.

One does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

1. You are ill or you have a health condition that would be significantly compromised if you were to contract a communicable illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
2. You are experiencing flu-like symptoms.
3. You have been exposed to someone who has tested positive, or you have reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness.
4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
5. You are pregnant.
6. You are 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own.
8. You have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by being at Mass.

Persons legitimately dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass are still to observe the Lord's Day by participating in a broadcast of the Sunday Mass or by spending time in prayer and meditating on Scripture, either individually or as a family.

General Guidelines:

*We will still require masks during all liturgies. Every person of the age of reason should wear a mask.

*We will maintain social distancing in our parishes, in accordance with guidance from the Centers for Disease Control.

*Churches should still be cleaned between liturgies.
