## SVdP Food Recovery Program Update

As you may recall, in November 2018, SVdP began a Food Recovery Program to recover edible food that would otherwise go to waste and distribute it to those in need in Hart County. We began a donor partnership with Quality Foods and subsequently added donors Rose Acre Farms, Hart Partners, Shank Bone Farms & Little Caesars Pizza. Our food recipients include 6 local "ministries" (e.g., Cornerstone Baptist Church, Hart County Cupboard Food Pantry, Hart Haven, etc.). The pizza is delivered to volunteers at 3 Hart Housing Authority complexes, a mobile home park, an assisted living complex, & a corrections facility. This is accomplished through the efforts of 15 Vincentians (i.e., 5 teams of 3). To date, we have recovered and returned over 30,000 meals to our community. This is the equivalent of feeding 1,907 families of four - or 7,628 of our neighbors in need. SVdP would like to thank the donors, the ministries, and the volunteers for their unselfish efforts.
