From the Pastor's Desk

Lent Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence from eating meat for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards. Even if a person is either above or below the age when fasting and abstinence are required, it can still be helpful to observe these penitential practices, provided it does not harm their strength or health.

Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving Suggestions for Families: Contribute together to a charity (I recommend doing the CRS Rice Bowl). Choose one or two things to give up as a family (sweets; screen time for entertainment). Choose a way to pray together as a family (pray before meals if you don't already; pray a rosary as a family 1x/week; come to the Stations of the Cross as a family)

Volunteer Position: Assistant to the Pastor for Religious Education set up. Tasks would include: collecting guild signs from classrooms; putting grade signs on pews; setting up projector and screen when needed; making copies as needed; preparing confessional spaces; other occasional tasks in consultation with the pastor. In general, be available to set up at 5:30pm on Wednesdays when we have religious education. This is a way to assist with religious ed without needing to teach. For more information visit with Fr. Kraemer.
