From the Pastor's Desk

Extra Confession times and Penance Services for Lent: Please see the other side of the bulletin for specific schedule. Every Catholic should recall Code of Canon Law 989 "After having reached the age of discretion [7 years or older], each member of the faithful is obliged to confess faithfully his or her grave sins at least once a year." It is helpful to one's progress in the Christian life to confess venial sins as well, and to go to confession more often. Bishop Folda recommends the faithful go to confession every 4-6 weeks. There can be personal situations which make a person unable to receive the sacraments. But there is still benefit to coming to Mass even if you cannot receive communion, and I am quite willing to work with you in whatever situation you find yourself.

Safe Haven Sunday follow up: Last weekend I preached about keeping your kids safe on the internet and spoke about the booklet "Connected: How Strong Family Relationships Lead to Internet-Safe Kids". I have a few extra copies in the entrance at St. Cecilia's if you would like one. Also, you can also receive a 7 day e-mail challenge from the books publishers, *Covenant Eyes*, by texting SECURE to 66866.

Volunteer Position: Assistant to the Pastor for Religious Education set up. Tasks would include: collecting guild signs from classrooms; putting grade signs on pews; setting up projector and screen when needed; making copies as needed; preparing confessional spaces; other occasional tasks in consultation with the pastor. In general, be available to set up at 5:30pm on Wednesdays when we have religious education. This is a way to assist with religious ed without needing to teach. For more information visit with Fr.
