**Bishop Folda** has asked that us priests pass on to you the following: Later this month the U.S. Congress will vote to repeal the Hyde Amendment. The Hyde Amendment prohibits the use of taxpayer dollars to fund abortions, and there is a campaign among many democrats and the Biden administration to repeal it. Our North Dakota representatives in the senate and house are with us on the issue (i.e., opposed to taxpayer funding of abortion), so it may not be necessary to contact them.
