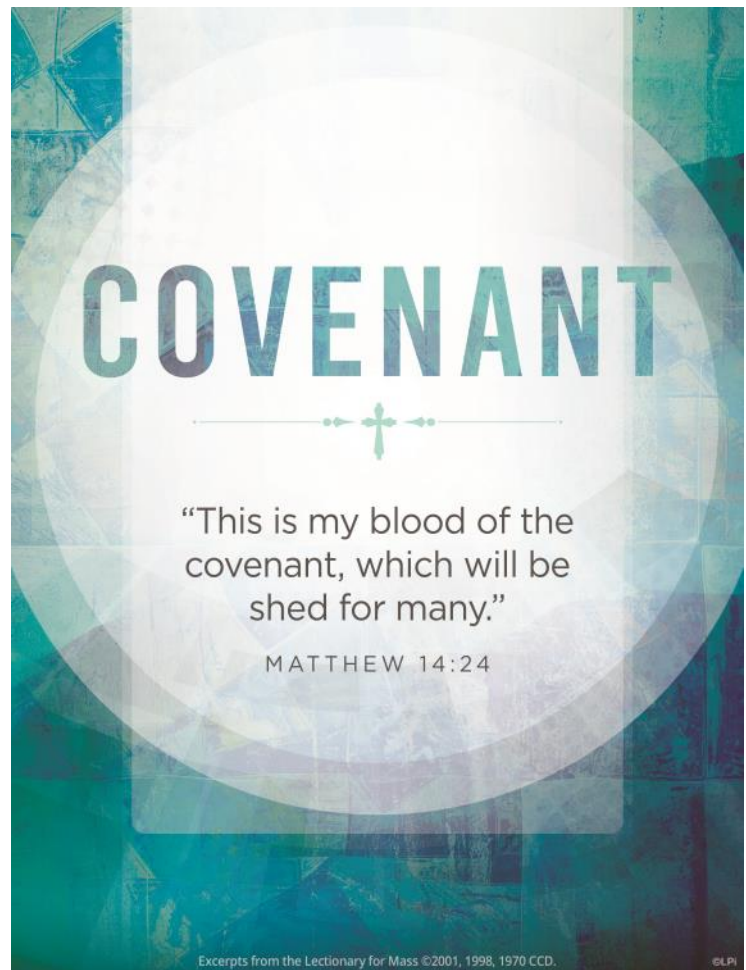

Father Gosselin served as pastor in Ontario, New Hampshire and Louisiana and continues to work part of each year in Haiti. It is out of deep respect for their dignity that, humbled but privileged, he dares to be the voice of the voiceless.



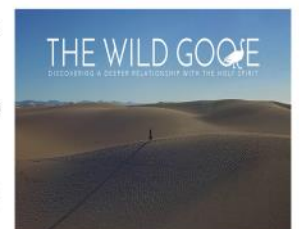

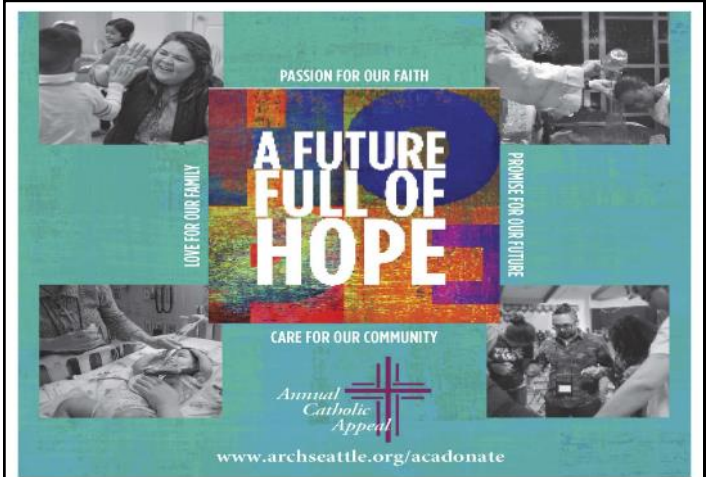
