Updates for weekly Bulletin: (50-75 words)

The CSJ Ministry council began with updates for current CSJ ministries including [the Mental Health and Addiction Ministry](#), [Mental Health Connect/Lumen Connect](#), and the Highland Heritage project.

Discussion moved to the first LCCC Parish Council 2021 Goal of Awareness focusing on racial injustice. The SJ Committee already has some ongoing projects focusing on awareness of racial injustice including a Land Acknowledgement project as part of the Highland Heritage project, and the "I Have a Dream" project put forth by the [rRacism](#) subgroup of the SJ Committee. Other suggestions for raising awareness of racial injustice included a book club and outreach to the Ethiopian Orthodox Community at the old St. Terese's site.
