Order of Acceptance Policy

Revised December 3, 2014

St. Peter Catholic School, as a ministry of St. Peter Parish, is grounded in the spiritual and moral teachings of the Catholic Church. For this reason, St. Peter 's Admission Policy gives priority to families who are registered in their church parish, actively practicing their faith, and contributing financially to the support of their parish. (St. Peter Parish - \$450.00 per year prior to December 31st).

The order of acceptance, depending on space available, is as follows:

Siblings of current students

Children of territorial parishioners who are deemed active by the pastor; children of alumni or legacy families as determined by the pastor

Children of territorial parishioners of a parish without a school or no room in their territorial parish school who are deemed active by their pastor

Children of non-territorial parishioners of a parish without a school or no room in their parish school who are deemed active by their pastor

Children of active parishioners who live outside the territorial parish in a parish with a school that has no room

All others – including inactive parishioners, non-Catholics, etc.

St. Peter Catholic School admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin.

A waiting list will be maintained throughout the year for the purpose of filling any vacancy that occurs during the year. Vacancies will be filled in the order of acceptance noted above.
