### Talent Show Important Dates:

1. Each participant is encouraged to attend the informational meeting and/or email Ms. Tumbleston with any questions. Participants **MUST ATTEND** both rehearsals, remaining until the end of rehearsal. See the schedule below for these dates:

Friday, April 30th	Informational meeting during recess under pavilion (Forms are not due but Mrs. Siverd is available to answer your questions.)
Wednesday, May 19th	Pavilion — PARENTS MUST ATTEND, details to come! (Rehearsal & to determine act line-up)
Friday, May 21st	Pavilion (Dress Rehearsal) - PARENTS MUST ATTEND, details to come!
Monday, May 24th	Show Time! Event will take place during school hours!

- Each act cannot exceed **THREE MINUTES**. Music CD's must be turned in with application for content review. \*\*\*
- Each act, including costume, must be approved prior to the Talent Show. You must wear your stage costume to the dress rehearsal. If you come to the Talent Show without your costume or if you have a different costume, you WILL NOT be allowed to perform. Costumes should be modest. Leotards alone and spaghetti straps will not be permitted. Tank tops, with a minimum 3-finger width shoulder strap, will be allowed. Belly buttons must be covered. Costumes will be disallowed according to school administration's discretion. Please keep in mind that we are a Catholic community- performance, music, costume and language should be appropriate.
- Music must be submitted by Wednesday, May 12th. Audio file may be emailed or sent in on a CD or jump drive. **\*\* Approved music can be found at [www.stpetercov.org](http://www.stpetercov.org). If your song is not on this list it will be forwarded to Mr. Clint Goss for approval. \*\***
- No student is allowed to perform in more than ONE act.
- No two acts will be allowed to contain the same song or routine, including songs heard in medleys. **THE FIRST ACT TO TURN IN A SONG NAME WILL BE ALLOWED TO USE THAT SONG!!**
- EVERY applicant needs an application/permission form.**
- A judge's panel will determine 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners. All participants will receive a participation award.
- You must be a St. Peter Catholic School STUDENT or STAFF MEMBER to participate...TEACHERS are WELCOME!**
