All volunteers are required to obtain VIRTUS certification prior to volunteering at the school. “Volunteering” includes but is not limited to providing classroom assistance, chaperoning for field trips, supervision, and all activities that include children. **No exceptions will be made in this regard.**

All volunteers need to report to the school office and have prior authorization from the principal for performing their voluntary service. Only those who are 18 years or older and VIRTUS certified may work for service hours.
