Student Uniform Policy

When we begin school in August, some of our new uniform items will not be immediately available. In the meantime, we will use this TEMPORARY school dress code:

Preschool: Preschool students are not required to wear the SMCS uniform. Preschool students should wear clothes that are comfortable, versatile, and durable. If a concern arises with the clothing of a Preschool student, the teacher will communicate with parent/guardian to rectify the issue.

K-8 students: It is unlikely that embroidered Schoolbelles polo shirts will be available by August 10. In the meantime, any color polo shirt may be worn (must be tucked in). Students are encouraged to wear uniform shirts from last school year if possible. We have many used polo shirts at the school which will be made available for free at the Ice Cream Social. T-shirts, sweatshirts, hoodies, etc. are not allowed.

Undershirts may be worn under the polo shirt, but undershirt must not be visible

Entirely black shoes (shoes must be 100% black, athletic shoes are allowed, no boots or booties)

Entirely black socks that fully cover the ankle must be worn

Schoolbelles grey pants (or shorts for boys) are preferred, which can be purchased at schoolbelles.com. If grey pants or shorts are not received by August 10, any color dress pants (or shorts for boys) are allowed. Students are encouraged to wear uniform pants from last school year if possible. We have many pairs of pants (and some shorts for boys) at the school which will be made available for free at the Ice Cream Social. Jeans, athletic pants, etc. are not allowed.

Black magnetic belts are preferred (available soon at the school office)

If black magnetic belts are not available by August 10, any color belt may be worn

Girls K-8: There will be a significant delay in getting the new plaid skirts and jumpers from Schoolbelles. In the meantime, girls may wear their jumper or skirt from last school year if possible. We have many jumpers and skirts at the school which will be made available for free at the Ice Cream Social. Girls may not wear shorts, or any skirt/jumper that is not school-issued. Third grade girls who have jumpers leftover from last year may wear them until their skirts come in.

When wearing pants, black magnetic belts are preferred (available soon at the school office)

If black magnetic belts are not available by August 10, any color belt may be worn

While wearing a jumper or skirt, girls ...

... may wear tights or leggings (must be entirely black)

... who wear tights may choose not to wear socks

... who do not wear tights/leggings must wear modesty shorts under their jumper/skirt
