Youth Ministry Policies 2021-2022

Meeting Information

The Edge Middle School Youth Ministry Program meets on the 2nd and 4th Sundays in Visitation Hall from 5:00-6:30 PM (effective 2022). Prior to 2022, Edge will meet on a slightly different schedule: October 31 from 1:30-3:30 and November 14, December 5, and December 12 from 5:00-6:30.

The Life Teen High School Youth Ministry Program will start in 2022 (date to be determined) on the 2nd and 4th Sundays in Visitation Hall from 7:00-8:30 PM.

Dismissal

Children should be dropped off in front of the church and proceed directly to Visitation Hall upon arrival. Core Team Members and/or Teen Leaders will be out in front of the church at the beginning of every Edge event. Children will be dismissed and escorted to the front of the church at the end of youth group and should be picked up at the front of the church. An adult will be with the children until all students have been picked up. Children will only be released to the individual(s) who were approved pick up permission by the parent/guardian on the registration form. If changes need to be made throughout the course of the year, please contact the Youth Ministers.

Courtesy

At all youth ministry events, participation and good manners are expected.

Attendance

The Youth Ministers hope to see active and consistent participation and attendance at all youth ministry programs. We encourage students to bring friends regardless of church affiliation/denomination.

Illness

If your child is sick, please keep them home! If there is a possibility that your child attended youth ministry while they had or if they have been exposed to COVID-19, please promptly contact the Youth Ministers.

Security

For the safety of all of our youth ministry participants, please drop off and pick up in front of the church. Teens who drive, please use the parking lot in front of the church.

Personal Possessions

Cell phones and other electronics should be turned off and placed out of sight during youth ministry.

Continuity

The vision for The Edge children is that they will transition into a participant in the Life Teen Program and/or become an Edge Teen Leader. The vision for our Life Teen participants is that they participate in youth ministry all throughout their high school years, and for those seniors who will be transitioning to life after high school, they will be well equipped to continue their spiritual journey away from home and our parish. The more participation, the greater the opportunities for events such as: National Youth Conferences, retreats, outreach, and summer mission trips.

Spiritual Elements/Activities

All youth ministry participants will have the opportunity to pray, read scripture, attend confession, participate in Eucharistic Adoration, and from time to time attend Mass.

Cancellation of Classes

In case of severe weather, the Youth Ministers will attempt to contact parents through the Remind App. Safety first! If you suspect driving is unsafe, don't come. Details for setting up the Remind App are down below under the communication section.

Discipline

Youth Ministers/Core Team Members will handle minor discipline offenses. However, if a child's behavior becomes disruptive, the Youth Minister will contact the parent/guardian to develop a plan moving forward.
