ST. ANNE COMMUNITY OUTREACH

FOOD

11,732 people were fed by groceries distributed to 4,323 families. Each family's week of groceries cost only \$4.59 per individual. Additionally 1,231 families were provided much-needed hygiene products.

CLOTHING

5,981 people received either gently-used or new clothing. Socks, underwear, church clothes, school uniforms and winter coats were just some of the items provided.

HOUSING

\$103,758.83 of financial assistance, in addition to education and advocacy, helped terminate evictions and restore utilities for 301 families.

MEDICAL

246 people were provided with necessary prescriptions, Ensure, Depends, bed pads or other medical supplies.
