Major Distinctions Between Guidance



Outdoor Seated Live Event

- Attendees be seated – no mingling, dancing, mixing
- Advance registration
- Maximum capacity based on:
 - [Blueprint Tier](#)
 - Negative test result or proof of vaccination
 - In-state visitors (unless fully vaccinated)



Outdoor Seated Live Event

PURPLE (WIDESPREAD) - TIER 1

- 100 people maximum, regardless of venue size
- Regional spectators only (within 120 miles)

RED (SUBSTANTIAL) – TIER 2

- 25% capacity

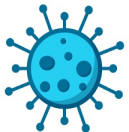
ORANGE (MODERATE) – TIER 3

- 33% capacity*

**may be increased to 67% capacity if attendees provide a negative test result within 72 hours of the event*

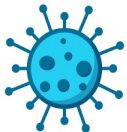
YELLOW (MINIMAL) – TIER 4

- 67% capacity



Indoor Seated Live Event

- Similar to Outdoor Seated Events:
 - Must be seated – no mingling, dancing, mixing
 - Advance registration
 - Maximum capacity based on:
 - [Blueprint Tier](#)
 - Negative test result or proof of vaccination
 - In-state visitors (unless fully vaccinated)
- Indoor event exceptions:
 - Not allowed in the Purple Tier
 - [Blueprint Tier](#) determines:
 - Food and concessions
 - Capacity limits based on venue size (see next slide)



Indoor Seated Live Event

PURPLE (WIDESPREAD) - TIER 1

- Not permitted

RED (SUBSTANTIAL) – TIER 2

Venues 0-1,500:

- Maximum 10% or 100 people
- 25% permitted if all guests show a negative test or proof of vaccination

Venues 1,501 + :

- 20% permitted if all guests show a negative test or proof of vaccination

ORANGE (MODERATE) – TIER 3

Venues 0-1,500:

- Maximum 15% or 200 people
- 35% permitted if all guests show a negative test or proof of vaccination

Venues 1,501 + :

- Maximum 10% or 2000 (whatever is fewer)
- No eating/drinking
- 35% permitted if all guests show a negative test or proof of vaccination

YELLOW (MINIMAL) – TIER 4

Venues 0-1,500:

- Maximum 25% or 300 people
- 50% permitted if all guests show a negative test within 72 hours of the event or proof of vaccination

Venues 1,501 + :

- Maximum 10% or 2000 (whatever is fewer)
- No eating/drinking
- 50% permitted if all guests show a negative test within 72 hours of the event or proof of vaccination

Graduation and Commencement

Key Considerations

Ensure all persons in attendance (students, families, school staff, volunteers, etc.) should be counted towards the capacity limit

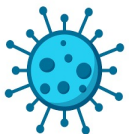
- Assign seating
- Limit attendee groups to a household unit. People from the same household do not need to be six feet apart.
- Maintain 6ft distance between households

Maintain 12ft distance and barrier between graduates and those on stage



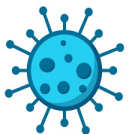
Private Venues and Events

Includes, but not limited to:

- Proms
- Off-campus award ceremony

Key Considerations

- Pre-determined guest list required
- Assigned seating
- Mandatory masks
- Follow [Indoor](#) or [Outdoor](#) Live Seated events
Guidance if live entertainment is provided
- Capacity limits based on Blueprint Tiers (next slide)
 - **Indoors requires negative test / proof of vaccination**



PURPLE (WIDESPREAD) - TIER 1

Outdoor

- Limited to 25 people
- Maximum of 100 people with proof of negative test or full vaccination

Indoor

- Not permitted

RED (SUBSTANTIAL) – TIER 2

Outdoor

- Limited to 50 people
- Maximum of 200 people with proof of negative test or full vaccination

Indoor

- Limited to 100 people
- All attendees must show proof of negative test or full vaccination

ORANGE (MODERATE) – TIER 3

Outdoor

- Limited to 100 people
- Maximum of 300 people with proof of negative test or full vaccination

Indoor

- Limited to 150 people
- All attendees must show proof of negative test or full vaccination

YELLOW (MINIMAL) – TIER 4

Outdoor

- Limited to 200 people
- Maximum of 400 people with proof of negative test or full vaccination

Indoor

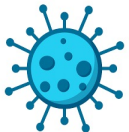
- Limited to 200 people
- All attendees must show proof of negative test or full vaccination

Gatherings

Key Considerations

- Maintain at least 6-ft distance between people
- Mandatory face masks
- Must be 2 hours or less
- Capacity levels based on tier and indoor/outdoor (see next slide)

- Includes, but not limited to:
 - Grad night
 - School field day
 - Off-campus swim party for a class
 - Prom
- **Not required:**
 - Pre-determined guest list
 - Assigned seating
- **Assumption:** all attendees are *not* vaccinated
 - Indoor gatherings at red, orange, and yellow tiers are strongly discouraged

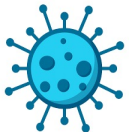


Gatherings

PURPLE (WIDESPREAD) - TIER 1	
<p><u>Outdoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Limited to no more than 3 households	<p><u>Indoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Not permitted
RED (SUBSTANTIAL) – TIER 2	
<p><u>Outdoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum of 25 people	<p><u>Indoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum 25% capacity where capacity limits existsLimited to 3 households or 10 people
ORANGE (MODERATE) – TIER 3	
<p><u>Outdoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum of 50 people	<p><u>Indoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum 25% capacity where capacity limits existsLimited to 25 people (or 25% capacity, whichever is fewer)
YELLOW (MINIMAL) – TIER 4	
<p><u>Outdoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum of 100 people	<p><u>Indoor</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum 50% capacity where capacity limits existsLimited to 50 people (or 50% capacity, whichever is fewer)

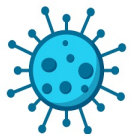
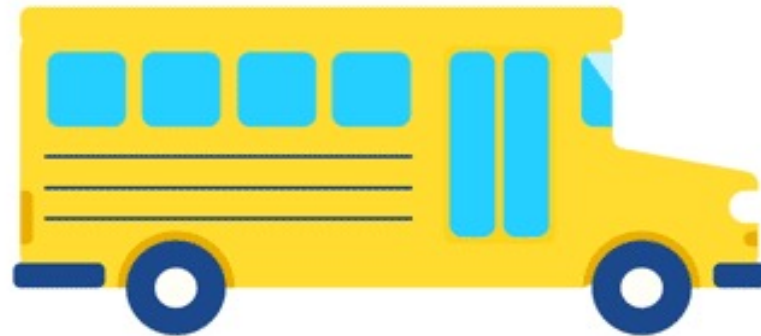
In sum, what requirements can your school currently meet at the event site?

- ❑ Proof of a negative COVID-19 test or vaccination status
- ❑ Assigned seating coordination
- ❑ Pre-determined list of all attendees (capacity)
- ❑ Outdoors vs. indoors
- ❑ Advance tickets / registration



Field Trips

- Field trips are allowed!
- [K-12 Guidance](#) (face coverings, stable groups, bus ventilation and spacing requirements) should be followed

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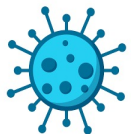
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Field Trip Check-List



- Ensure all students have masks and extra masks are available
- Complete symptom check of all students and staff attendees prior to leaving
- Create seating plan based on maximum capacity
- Remind attendees to bring their own packed lunch or provide lunch boxes on site
- Ensure 6ft distancing when lining up and moving on/off the bus
- Choose outdoor vs. indoor destinations
- Limit interactions with other visitors at destination
- No sharing facility space with other schools at the same time



Summary

- ❑ Know what criteria your school can meet ahead of planning - assigned seating, pre-registration, indoor/outdoor, capacity, county's Blueprint tier)
- ❑ Have a **communications plan** to share on multiple platforms, languages, etc. so that students and families are not surprised or disappointed
- ❑ Encourage the use of **negative tests** and proof of **full vaccination** – this provides much more flexibility and prevention of transmission
- ❑ Ensure the use of **face coverings** – no matter what the event, venue or activity
