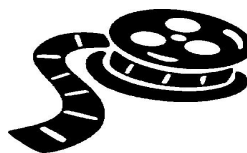
### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

CCD classes will be starting. soon. Watch for announcements.

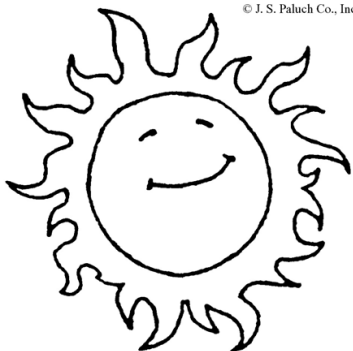
