"I decided that's something I'd like to do," said MaryJane who enjoys cooking for others. And there was a need for leadership of The Martha's who often, if requested by a deceased person's family, prepared food for funeral receptions held in the parish hall after the church service. Volunteer duties include setting up and taking down tables and cleaning up as well as preparing food for the funeral reception. Members of The Martha's can also help a parishioner who is too ill to cook for himself/herself by bringing a meal to his/her home during the period of illness.

At the moment, according to MaryJane, there are 10 people on the list of The Martha's volunteers. A new list was recently started because the old list was outdated with volunteers moving out of town, leaving St. Pat's, passing away, etc. Therefore, MaryJane requests that, if your name was on the old list and you wish to continue to serve as a member of The Martha's, you call the parish office, 423-2846, or stop by to place your name on the new list. The parish office is open Tues., 1-4 p.m. and Wed. through Fri., 9 a.m.-12 noon and 1-4 p.m.

Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) Starts Soon

Are you interested in becoming Catholic or knowing more about the Catholic faith?

Are you a non-Catholic visitor to St. Patrick Church who feels drawn to the Catholic faith?

Do you desire to be baptized?

Were you baptized in another faith but are considering to join the Catholic church?

Were you baptized Catholic but not raised in the Catholic faith and never received the Sacrament of Confirmation?

Are you married to a Catholic and desire to worship fully as a family at St. Patrick's?

If you answered "yes" to any of these questions, then RCIA may be meant for you.

The RCIA program is a discernment process that exerts absolutely no pressure on its participants.

Catholics who are already in full communion with the Catholic church and want to learn more about their faith may also benefit from participation in the RCIA program

Beginning August 22 and continuing through mid-May of 2018, RCIA classes will be held every Tuesday evening. If you are interested in attending, you may register for the classes in the Rose Room after the Masses during the weekends of July 22-23 and August 6-7. You may also sign up by stopping at the parish office during regular office hours. A registration fee of \$35 is requested to help defray a portion of the cost of instructional materials. Assistance is available for those unable to pay the fee at the time of registration. The deadline to register is August 8 after which a \$10 late fee may be assessed to offset the purchase of additional resources.

"Frequently, someone comes or returns to the Catholic church simply because of a friend, a friend who cared enough to invite them." said Vern Funsch, St. Patrick's RCIA program coordinator. Perhaps you have a friend who is waiting to be invited.
