



## Parish Community Comes Together For Successful Move

It was an amazing sight. Young and old and every age in between were pitching in as the parishioners from St. Patrick Church responded to Pastor Tony Quijano's call for help with the move on Sat., Aug. 3, of boxes, furniture, appliances, and miscellaneous items from the parish offices in the old rectory and Moiola Hall.

Coming together at 8 a.m. for prayer and assignments the large group of men, women and a few children finished the job in approximately four hours as they efficiently filled the Western Nevada Supply trailers for the transfer of all the goods to 5,000 square feet of available space in the old Walmart adjacent to the Safeway Store only a short distance away. The volunteers exemplified a true team effort in accomplishing a singular goal.

The move was scheduled in advance of crews from Diversified Builders preparing the two buildings for demolition expected to begin on Mon., Aug. 19. Moiola Hall and the old rectory will be replaced by one 10,000 square foot facility housing several offices, an assembly hall of significant size, a fully-equipped kitchen, a laundry room, religious education classrooms, and, of course, restrooms. Construction is expected to be completed in six months (Feb. 2014).
