This obligation will be reinstated effectively on June 6, 2021, the Feast of Corpus Christi.

COVID – If you are vaccinated you no longer need to wear a mask or physically distance from others. If you are not vaccinated or prefer to take certain precautions, the CDC and Commonwealth direct you to wear a mask and distance from others outside your household. Thank you for your collaboration!
