### Freedom of The Spirit

In today's scripture readings, Moses wishes for God's gift to be distributed as widely as possible. St. James addresses himself to those of us who have an abundance of material goods, warning us that we have effectively become idolaters, valuing our wealth over humans who are God's image and likeness in the world. In the Gospel Jesus warns us, his followers against preserving rank and giving scandal. Jesus encourages us to look beyond the parameters we have set for ourselves and for him. If God has called even us to follow Jesus, why couldn't God call others too? Where do these messages hit home for you?

## 2021 DIOCESAN ROSARY CONGRESS

**Bishop Cahill has announced a Diocesan Rosary Congress throughout the Diocese of Victoria, October 3 – 10, 2021**

The 2021 Diocesan Rosary Congress begins with an opening Mass at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Victoria on Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9 a.m. This year's theme is *Immersing the Family in the Contemplation of Christ our Peace*.



October 3<sup>rd</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> will be a time of intense prayer by the faithful of the entire Diocese before our Eucharistic Lord using the Holy Rosary to pray for:

- Peace throughout the world, especially peace in the Middle East; for an end to the conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan; and for God's protection for all our military personnel, especially those serving overseas.

- Our families, that the Holy Spirit may give us wisdom and courage; that our homes may be safe "nests" where life is nurtured and cherished; and that we may be open to the forgiveness and mercy that flows from the heart of Jesus.

- Those who feel distanced from Jesus and feel "lost," that the Holy Spirit may give them hope; that we may have listening hearts and be instruments of healing; that the Church may be open and welcoming to all those in need.

- The sins committed by our bishops and priests, that the Holy Spirit may bring healing to those who have been abused; that those who have committed grave sins may be led to conversion and accountability; that the Church may defend and proclaim the value of every human life

**There will be the recitation of the Holy Rosary in Moulton**

- During the First Friday Adoration; after the 8:00 a.m. Mass on October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Before the 6:30 p.m. Mass on October 2<sup>nd</sup> and before the 9:30 a.m. Mass on October 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- There will be a Public Recitation of the Rosary on Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup> at the Downtown Gazebo at 9:30 a.m. organized by the Christian Mothers.

All parishioners are invited and are also encouraged to privately pray the Rosary during the week of Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>.
