Understanding the VIRTUS® “Protecting God’s Children” program

Child sexual abusers often target nurturing, child-friendly environments, where parents and participants assume that no one would ever want to harm a child. Religious organizations are prime examples. The Catholic Church has adapted the VIRTUS® Protecting God’s Children program to send a message to potential predators that child sexual abuse is not tolerated. Through this program, adults learn that through early identification, awareness, and education they can be “proactive” in protecting children and young people from child sexual abuse. Origins of the Devotion

Our Lady of Rosa Mystica is a Marian advocacy that goes back to the days of the Apostles. It refers to Mary as Mother of the Mystical Body of Christ, or Mother of the Church. We can find this name in the Litany of Loreto and images as early as the 1300’s.

As Mother of the Church, Virgin Mary has been requesting a particular devotion for the protection and strengthening of priests and religious orders, and for the flourishing of vocations. This request was inspired first to Pierina Gilli in Italy in the 1940’s.

What is the feast of the Most Holy Name of Mary?

The Most Holy Name of Mary feast day honors Mary, the Mother of God, as blessed. It takes place each year on September 12th, four days after the feast of the Birth of the Blessed Mother. The feast day encourages us all to pray for her intercession to deepen our love of Christ and our relationship with the Lord.

Importance to the Oblate Communities

The Oblates of the Virgin Mary have a special connection with Mary and pray often for her intercession. Venerable Bruno Lanteri, who founded the Oblates of the Virgin Mary, said “the Congregation of the Oblates is not my work, but the work of Mary Most Holy... She is its foundress, its mother, and its teacher.” The devotion of the Oblates is also expressed through our motto, “Think of Mary; call out to Mary.”

### Children's Corner



A child can be compared to a "sponge". The nature of the sponge is that it absorbs, either dirty water or clear, crystalline water! Place a 3 or 4 year old in front of the TV. set and he can repeat what he hears, often vulgar words, or bad scenes he has viewed. Why not teach the child in his fresh, fertile, virgin mind—as soon as possible—the prayers, "Dear Angel of God..." "Our Father..." "Hail Mary..." "Glory be..." "Jesus I love you!!!" The parents are the prime educators of the child, especially in the realm of faith and as teachers of prayer! Parents be responsible! It is your duty to provide the most efficacious means for the salvation of your children. Remember the words of St. Augustine: "He who prays well lives well; he who lives well dies well; he who dies well all is well."

*Se puede comparar a un niño con una "esponja". La naturaleza de la esponja es que absorbe, ya sea agua sucia o agua clara y cristalina. Ponga a un niño de 3 o 4 años delante del televisor y podrá repetir lo que oye, a menudo palabras vulgares, o las malas escenas que ha visto. ¿Por qué no enseñar al niño en su mente fresca, fértil y virgen -lo antes posible- las oraciones: "Ángel de mi guarda..." "Padre nuestro..." "Ave María..." "Gloria..." "¡Jesús te amo!" ¡Los padres son los primeros educadores del niño, especialmente en el ámbito de la fe y como maestros de la oración! ¡Padres sean responsables! Es vuestro deber proporcionar los medios más eficaces para la salvación de vuestros hijos. Recordad las palabras de San Agustín: "Quien reza bien, vive bien; quien vive bien, muere bien; quien muere bien, todo está bien".*
