

RCIA Registration Form

Welcome to St. Mark's RCIA program!

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) program is a process marked by study and discussion by which non-baptized men and women enter the Catholic Church. It follows the ancient practice of the Church, restored by the Second Vatican Council, and is the normal way for adults to learn about the faith in a mature setting with other like-minded persons having the intention of becoming Catholic.

Here at St. Mark's we conduct a two-track program for those persons who are already baptized Catholics and wish to complete their Initiation into the Church by receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation and those who desire to become Catholic either by Baptism or who were Baptized in another Christian tradition but wish to be received into the Catholic Church

Led by Deacon Chris Sandner (dnchris@sbpr.org), the program commences about a week after the new school year begins. The exact schedule is available at the parish website (<https://saint-marks.net/adult-religious-education-rcia>). The program concludes with the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation) at the Easter Vigil and prior to graduation in the Spring.

The program consists of approximately 18-20 evening sessions of study and discussion using the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) as the primary resource. Attendance at a retreat in the Spring is required and is the highlight of the entire process. More details and all of your questions will be handled at our first meeting.
