Haman will contact DRN to see about installing it.

Security Camera around the church property: There was some discussion of security around the church. It was felt that we should install security cameras at the front door of the church, the front and back of the Parish Hall. It is felt that it would be better to be proactive in the case of security.

Father will contact board member via email with the information that he receives concerning both live streaming and security cameras.
