

Guidance and Procedures 9.9.21

Social Distancing

- Three feet or greatest distance possible.
- Students are permitted to work in groups.
- No need to separate homerooms in the school yard.

Cleaning

- Continue with increased cleaning of common areas and frequently used features such as door knobs, handrails and counters.
- We will wipe lunch tables down after each lunch session.
- Students will wash hands and sanitize frequently.
- Cleaning before and after using shared equipment.

Masking

- Masks are mandated for use in schools per the Archdiocese. We will make steps to have masking optional as long as the level of Covid is low or moderate.
- The level of Covid in the community will determine whether masking is mandated or optional.
- Low and Moderate- masks are optional
- Substantial and High- masks are mandatory
- Masks are not required outdoors.
- Masks are not required during gym class when they are exerting themselves.

Monitoring

- Parents are primarily responsible for monitoring the health of their children.
- Children presenting symptoms must not come to school.

Suspected Case of Covid- Response to Exposure

Unvaccinated Student Wearing a Mask

- Will need to continue to wear a mask
- Will not need to quarantine
- If tested and results are positive, then quarantine for 10 days

Unvaccinated Student Without a Mask

- Will need to quarantine for 5 days minimum
- At 5th day; get a Covid test
- If test is negative, the child can return after 7 days
- If test is positive, or not tested, return after 10 days from exposure.

Vaccinated Student

- Will not need to quarantine
- If tested and results are positive, then quarantine for 10 days
- Get tested 2-5 days after exposure, even if asymptomatic

Close Contact

Unvaccinated wearing a mask

- Does not have to quarantine
- Should have a test if they start showing signs of being sick
- If sick then quarantine

Vaccinated wearing a mask

- Does not need to quarantine unless showing symptoms.
