RAISING CHILDREN

"Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it." —Prov 22:6

Raising children in the faith is a fundamental responsibility of Catholic parents. As St Augustine (d. 430) said: "Let the blessings of marriage be loved: offspring, fidelity, and the sacramental bond. Offspring, not so much because it may be born, but because it can be reborn." To be effective channels of grace, parents must not only persevere in prayer and faithfully receive the Sacraments, they must pray for their children's eternal welfare. For this purpose, specific prayers are suggested below.

- 1. SALVATION. O Lord, let salvation spring up within my children, that they may obtain the life that is in Christ Jesus, eternal glory (see Isa 45:8; 2 Tim 2:10).
- 2. GROWTH IN GRACE. Grant that my children may grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (see 2 Pet 3:18).
- 3. LOVE. Grant that my children may learn to live a life of love through the Spirit who dwells in them (see Gal 5:25; Eph 5:2).
- 4. HONESTY AND INTEGRITY. May integrity and honesty be their virtue and their protection (see Ps 25:21).
- 5. SELF-CONTROL. Help my children be alert and self- controlled in all they do (see 1 Thess 5:6).
- 6. LOVE FOR SACRED SCRIPTURE.

 May my children grow to find Sacred



- Scripture more precious than gold and sweeter than honey from the comb (see Ps 19:10).
- 7. JUSTICE. Help my children to love justice and to act justly in all they do (see Ps 11:7; Mic 6:8)
- 8. MERCY. May my children always be merciful, just as the Father is merciful (see Luke 6:36).
- 9. RESPECT (for Self, Others, and Authority). Grant that my children may show proper respect to everyone, to see and serve Christ is everyone they meet (see 1 Pet 2:17).
- 10. SELF-ESTEEM. Help my children develop a strong self-esteem rooted in the realization that they are God's workmanship, created anew in Christ Jesus (see Eph 2:10).
- 11. FAITHFULNESS. Bind the virtues of love and faithfulness around the necks of my children, and write them on the tablets of their hearts (see Prov 3:3).
- 12. COURAGE. May my children be strong and courageous in their character and in their actions (see Deut 31:6)
- 13. PURITY. Create in them a pure heart, O God, and let that purity of heart be shown in all they do (see Ps 51:10).
- 14. KINDNESS. May my children always be kind to each other and to everyone else (see 1 Thess 5:15).
- 15. GENEROSITY. May my children be generous and willing to share, and so lay up treasure for themselves in Heaven (see 1 Tim 6:18-19).
- 16. PEACE-LOVING. May they pursue that which leads to peace and builds up others (see Rom 14:19).
- 17. JOY. Fill my children with the joy given by the Holy Spirit (see 1 Thess 1:6).
- 18. PERSEVERANCE. Teach my children the virtue of perseverance; to fight the good fight, to finish the course, to keep the faith (see 2 Tim 4:7).
- 19. HUMILITY. Cultivate in them the ability to walk humbly before you, O Lord (see Titus 3:2).
- 20. COMPASSION. Clothe my children with the virtue of compassion (see Col 3:12).
- 21. RESPONSIBILITY. Grant that my children may learn responsibility, for each should carry his own load (see Gal 6:5).
- 22. CONTENTMENT. Teach them the secret of being content in any and every situation, through Him who gives them strength (see Phil 4:12-13).
- 23. FAITH. May faith take root and grow in their hearts, that by faith they may gain what has been promised (see Luke 17:5-6; Heb 11:1-40).
- 24. A SERVANT'S HEART. Help my children develop a servant's heart in imitation of Jesus Christ Himself (see

- John 13:15).
- 25. HOPE. Grant that my children may overflow with hope and hopefulness by the power of the Holy Spirit (see Rom 15:13).
- 26. WORK ETHIC. Teach my children to value work and to serve you in all they do; to lift their hearts to you with their hands (see Col 3:23).
- 27. ZEAL. Instill in them the passion to "cling fast to you" (see Ps 63:8).
- 28. SELF-DISCIPLINE. Help them acquire the virtues of discipline and prudence, to always do what is right and just and fair (see Prov 1:3).
- 29. PRAYERFULNESS. Ceaselessly call my children to prayer, O Lord, that they may find in you the source of all that is good and holy (see 1 Thess 5:17).
- 30. GRATITUDE. Help my children to live lives overflowing with thankfulness, always giving thanks to the Father for everything in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ (see Eph 5:20; Col 2:7).
- 31. A HEART FOR MISSIONS. Help my children to see your glory declared among the nations, your marvelous deeds among the peoples (see Ps 96:3).
