VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Our Religious Education Program relies on our dedicated volunteers who serve as Catechists and Aides in our weekly classes. All catechist positions will be supported with resources and training from the Religious Education staff. We are currently taking volunteers for the 2021-2022 School Year:

- CATECHISTS, K-5th Grade. Teach and hand on the Catholic Faith during the Classroom Sessions.
- ASSISTANTS, K-5th Grade. Help with classroom activities, helping prepare the classroom and supporting the catechist in teaching the lessons.
- PROGRAM HELPERS. High schoolers or adults who support the program by monitoring the doors, escorting late-arriving children to class, patrolling the hallways during class for safety, and serving in any non-teaching capacity.
- GRADE 6 – 8 CORE TEAM. Adults or HS leaders to lead small groups as well as help teach and hand on the Catholic Faith during bi-weekly sessions.
- HIGH SCHOOL CORE TEAM. Adults committed to walking with HS teens on their faith journey, facilitating small groups and occasionally teaching a class..
- SUBSTITUTES. Volunteers who are willing to be called on an as needed basis to serve as a catechist or assistant.
- CHAPERONES: Adults willing to receive Safe Environment training and chaperone various youth ministry events (e.g. apple picking, youth conference, Christmas shopping trip, etc)
