PROFILE

HISTORY

Saint Agatha Church was established in 1940 in the heart of Upper Arlington, Ohio. In 1941, Saint Agatha School became the first Catholic school in the area and was staffed by the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth, Kentucky. Saint Agatha School has received the National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence Award three times in 1985, 2000 and 2015 and is the only school in the Columbus Diocese to have received this prestigious honor three times. The school celebrated its 75th Anniversary during the 2016-2017 school year.

SCHOOL YEAR

The school year is divided into four quarters. During each quarter parents receive interim progress reports followed by report cards. Parent/Teacher conferences are scheduled in November and February or upon request. The school day begins at 8:25 am and ends at 3:00 pm. Nutritious hot lunches, bus service from neighboring communities and a school nurse are all available.

AREAS OF STUDY

All students receive instruction in core subjects of Religion, Mathematics, Language Arts, Science, Health, Social Studies, Spanish and Latin (Grade 8). In addition, the following expanded programs with specialist instruction are offered: Art, Music, Band, Physical Education, Library Skills, Technology, Learning Support, Speech-Language Pathology and Guidance/Counseling.
