

Saint Pius X Catholic School-Uniform Guidelines, 2020-2021

Saint Pius administration reserves the right to render a final decision as to compliance with the dress code.

General Comments	Girls	Boys
<p><u>Preschool:</u> No uniform is required. Please dress children in weather appropriate “play clothes” that they can manage themselves and be comfortable wearing.</p> <p><u>General Uniform Grades K-8</u> BOTTOM No cargo pants or shorts, capris, ruffled, corduroy or worn. No jegging style pants may be worn.</p> <p>Pants and Shorts-Students must wear shorts/pants that are the proper waist size and wear them at the waist.</p> <p>Shorts, skirts and skorts must reach tip of fingers when standing.</p> <p>Elastic waistbands are allowed in grades K-3.</p> <p>Rolling- Students may not roll up the waist of the uniform skirt, skort, pants or gym shorts.</p> <p>Shorts may not be worn from November 1 through March 31.</p> <p>TOP Shirts must be sufficient length to be tucked in at all times.</p> <p>Tops may not have logos, emblems or symbols on them, with the exception of the SPX logo.</p> <p>If an undershirt is worn, it must be a plain white short sleeved shirt.</p> <p>All clothing should be clean and free of holes.</p>	<p><u>Girls' Uniform Grades K-8</u> BOTTOM Plaid jumper—v-neck or drop waist (purchased from Schoolbelles) (Grades K-3)</p> <p>Plaid skort or skirt (purchased from Schoolbelles) (Grades 3-8)</p> <p>Khaki skirt, or skort (available for purchase from Schoolbelles or Land’s End) (Grades 3-8)</p> <p>Slacks and shorts khaki uniform style, flat front or pleated. Straight legged (not elasticized at the bottom). No jegging style pants may be worn.</p> <p>Navy, white, khaki or hunter green tights or navy or black biker shorts must be worn under skirts or jumpers. Girls in grades K-8 may wear black or navy leggings under their skirts.</p> <p>TOP Peter pan blouse—long or short sleeve, white only; straight collar blouse-long or short sleeve.</p> <p>Polo shirts—navy or white, two or three-button, long or short sleeve, optional monogram on navy or white</p> <p>Polo shirt—hunter green, monogram required, long or short sleeve from Sports Image Apparel only.</p> <p>Turtleneck or mock style top, white only</p> <p>Cardigan sweater—navy or white</p> <p>V-neck sweater—Must be monogrammed, navy (must be purchased from Schoolbelles or Lands’ End)</p> <p>V-neck sweater vest-Must be monogrammed, navy (must be purchased from Lands’ End)</p> <p>1/4 zip fleece pullover-Must be monogrammed, hunter green or navy (must be purchased from Sports Image Apparel only)</p>	<p><u>Boys' Uniform Grades K-8</u> BOTTOM Khaki pants and shorts, flat front or pleated. Straight legged (not elasticized at the bottom).</p> <p>No cargo pants or shorts.</p> <p>TOP Polo shirts—navy or white, two or three-button, long or short sleeve, optional monogram on navy or white</p> <p>Polo shirt—hunter green, monogram required, long or short sleeve (must be purchased from Sports Image Apparel)</p> <p>Turtleneck or mock style top, white only</p> <p>V-neck sweater—Must be monogrammed, navy (must be purchased from Schoolbelles)</p> <p>V-neck sweater vest-Must be monogrammed, navy (must be purchased from Lands’ End)</p> <p>1/4 zip fleece pullover-Must be monogrammed, hunter green or navy (must be purchased from Sports Image Apparel)</p> <p>Students in grades 7 and 8 may wear a navy blue, Saint Pius X logo performance ¼ zip pull over (Lazer Graphics).</p>

Hair-	Hair- Haircuts, hair length, hair color and hair ornaments that distract from the conservative nature of the uniform codes are not permitted. Hair color must be a natural color. Hair ornaments should be non-neon.	Hair: Boys' hair should be cut in a conservative fashion. It should not be distracting and worn so that it does not cover the eyes or collar. Hair color must be a natural color. Facial Hair: Boys must be clean shaven.
Shoes- Shoes worn with the school uniform at Saint Pius should reflect the conservative nature of the uniform. Shoes should be athletic, dress, or casual dress and comfortable for the student. Shoes with fasteners must be fastened (laces=laced; buckles=buckled)	Girls' shoes must be solid or any combination of grey, khaki, brown, black, white or navy. No fur lining in shoes. Athletic, dress, casual dress or loafer style shoes are acceptable styles. Athletic shoes must have white, black or grey laces and soles. Closed toe, closed heel, flat shoes are acceptable styles. Shoe heels may not exceed 1". Sandals, open toe, and open heel shoes are not permitted. No boots for outdoor wear are permitted for indoor wear. No shoes with skates on the bottom may be worn.	Boys' shoes must be solid or any combination of grey, khaki, brown, black, white or navy. No fur lining in shoes. Athletic, dress, casual dress or loafer style shoes are acceptable styles. Athletic shoes must have white, black or grey laces and soles. Sandals, open toe, and open heel shoes are not permitted. No boots for outdoor wear are permitted for indoor wear. Socks-	Socks or tights must be worn at all times. Opaque, ribbed, or cabled tights are acceptable. Acceptable sock colors include solid white, black, grey, or navy. Socks may not have frills, picot edging, lace, ruffles, emblems, or other trims. If visible, socks may have a small logo that is about the size of a quarter. No neon colored logos.	Acceptable sock colors include solid white, black, grey, navy. Socks may not have frills, picot edging, lace, ruffles, emblems, or other trims. If visible, socks may have a small logo that is about the size of a quarter. No neon colored logos.
Jewelry- Students may wear a solid colored modest style watch (no neon, no smartwatches). A religious medal, cross or crucifix is permitted on a necklace. Bracelets may be worn that meet the conservative nature of the dress code. (No rings, anklets, or other jewelry.)	Jewelry: Girls may wear a single set of modest post-style earrings (no dangling earrings).	Jewelry: Boys may not wear earrings.
Belts- Students in grades 4-8 are required to wear a belt at all times. Belts must be plain with no designs or embellishments. Belt buckles are not allowed.	Belts- Black, navy blue, brown or khaki belts Elastic waistbands are allowed in grades K-3.	Belts- Black, navy blue, brown or khaki belts Elastic waistbands are allowed in grades K-3.
Body Piercing and Tattoos -Body piercing and tattoos (permanent or temporary) are not allowed.		
Nail Polish and Make-Up	Girls may wear only clear nail polish (no French manicures). Girls may wear clear lip balm or gloss (no color tints). No other make-up is allowed.	Boys may not wear nail polish or make-up of any kind.

Outerwear and Accessories

Outerwear is defined as anything worn over the standardized dress such as, but not limited to, jackets, coats, hoodies, sweatshirts, vests, pullovers, cover-ups, rainwear, etc. Trench coats and any other outerwear deemed by administration to be a distraction or potential safety hazard are not permitted.

Outerwear should be worn based on weather conditions. Outerwear should be worn before and after school, not in the building during the academic day. Students may not have jacket hoods on their heads inside the building during the academic day or during school sponsored events.

Nothing offensive on outerwear is allowed: no images, sayings, artwork, music groups, etc. are allowed; however, small brand logos (up to 2 inches in diameter) and appropriate brand wording is allowed.

Saint Pius X Catholic School does not have an award or letter jackets approved to be worn during school hours or events. (Please refer to the Saint Pius X Catholic Church Graphic Standards manual for information on use of official Saint Pius logos, tag lines, and wording).

All outerwear is approved at the discretion of administration. Saint Pius school administration has the authority to impose additional standards for outerwear and may require students to call home for replacement items if those standards are not met.

Accessories

Hats, scarves, gloves and sunglasses are special forms of outerwear that must be removed upon entering any school building (including the cafeteria). Nothing offensive on accessories is allowed: no images, sayings, artwork, music groups, etc. are allowed; however, small brand logos (up to 2 inches in diameter) and appropriate

Physical Education Dress Code

Gym uniform shorts, shirts, sweatpants and sweatshirts must be ordered from Lazer Graphics. Various orders will be placed throughout the school year for gym uniform attire.

Navy monogrammed athletic shorts and grey/navy-trimmed monogrammed shirt. Athletic shoes must be solid or any combination of grey, khaki, brown, black, white or navy. Shoes must have white, black or grey laces and soles. ***High top shoes are not acceptable.***

Students in grades K-6 must wear gym clothes to school on gym days. Students in these grades cannot wear standard uniform clothes and change for physical education class. Students must wear monogrammed navy sweatpants during the day from November 1 through March 31. Students may wear gym shorts under the sweatpants and remove the sweatpants for physical education class or participate in class wearing their sweatpants. Students in these grades must wear code compliant tennis shoes with their physical education uniforms to school. Lazer Graphics sweatshirts may be worn during school hours on gym days only.

Students in grades 7-8 must wear standard school uniform-wear on gym days and change their clothes and clean shoes for gym class. *Please note: Students who come to gym class without their gym uniform will receive a deduction for their participation grade that day and will be required to complete a reading/writing assignment during the scheduled class time.*
