MESSAGE FOR PARENTS: Regarding First Reconciliation and First Communion

Dear Parent(s) and or Guardian(s)

Our church has now reopened for Sunday Masses. As a result, we are able to begin to celebrate the sacrament of First Communion and First Reconciliation. The protocols, however, have changed.

Your child may receive the sacrament of first Holy Communion each week at any of our weekend Masses which will continue Saturdays at 5:00pm and Sundays at 9:30am and 11:30am. Scheduling will begin for the weekend of September 12/13 and continuing for the next six weekends until October 17/18. Only four families per Mass (Sat. 5:00pm, Sundays 9:30am & 11:30am), each weekend, can be accommodated due to safety protocols. There will be one pew of reserved seating for each family.

Registration will be on a first come first serve basis. Please let us know your choice of date and Mass time as soon as possible. Email your choice to jyoung@hamiltondiocese.com or call Cindy at the Parish office at 519-752-0361.

Candidates are invited to receive the Sacrament of First Reconciliation from Father Kevin before making their First Communion. You may bring your child on any Saturday starting the week of August 29th at 3:30pm till 4:15pm. Confessions take place outside the Church at the Rectory side porch which faces the side of the Church.

Children learn their faith not just through catechism classes but through experience by

practice. As Catholics we have an obligation to attend Mass every Sunday (under penalty of mortal sin). Hence, it is imperative that parents practice their faith as a family and bring their children to Mass every Sunday.

PLEASE NOTE:

* Children must be baptized prior to receiving First Communion.

*All participants except for children under the age of two years must wear a mask while inside the church in accordance with the City of Brantford Mask Bylaw.
