### SOCIETY OF ST VINCENT DE PAUL



The members of St Basil's Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP) would like to thank our parishioners for their continued support during the 2020 year. Your generosity enabled SSVP to distribute \$15,895.00 in food vouchers to our neighbours in need. In spite of very difficult circumstances because of COVID-19, society members made 377 home visits to 196 households, assisting 331 adults and 140 children.
