### **WORLD DAY OF GRANDPARENTS** **AND THE ELDERLY JULY 25<sup>th</sup>**

Pope Francis announced the establishment of a World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly. The chosen day for the yearly celebration is the fourth Sunday of July, since it coincides with the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.

This year, the first World Day celebration will take place on **Sunday, July 25 and the chosen theme is, "I am with you always"**.



**THE SPIRIT GARDEN TO BE INSTALLED AT NATHAN PHILLIPS SQUARE** in Toronto is another step closer to realization. Tenders for the project went out last week. The plan is to have shovels in the ground in September, with completion expected by September 2023!
