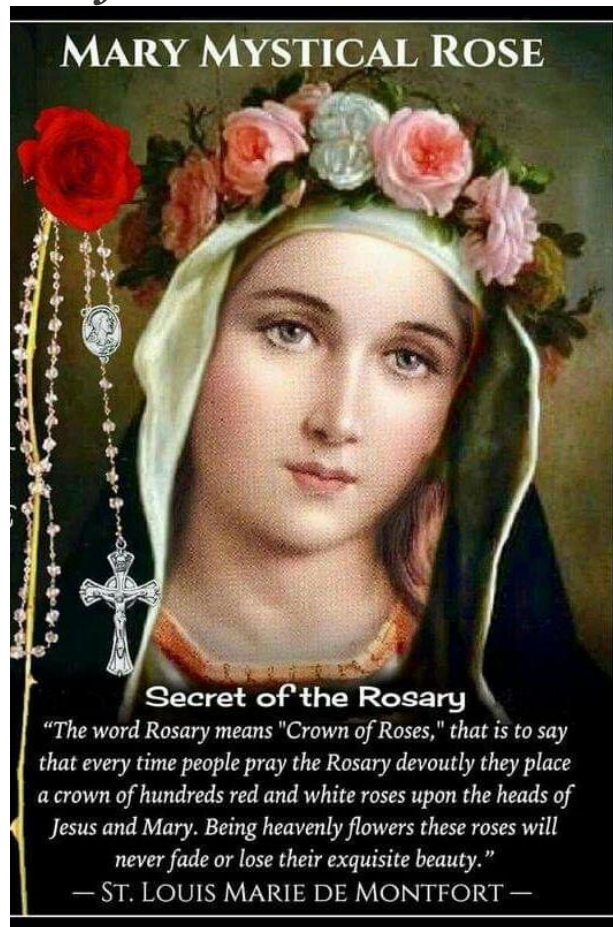

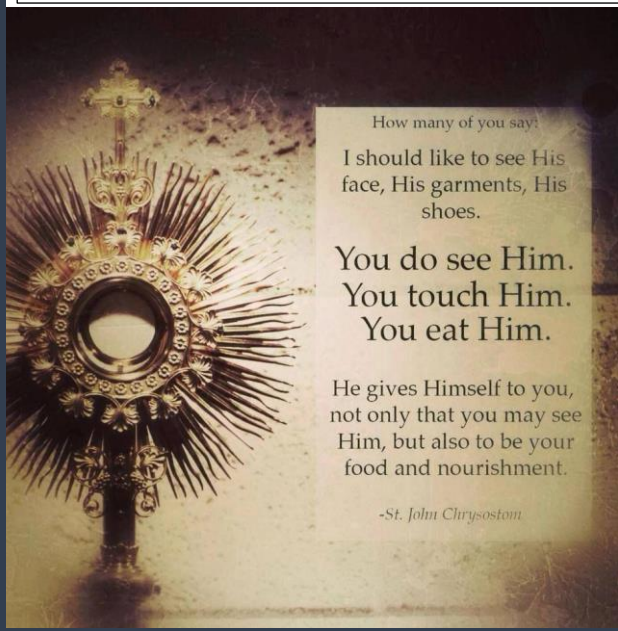

There is hardly a Catholic school in the country without its picture of the "Guardian Angel" --- the two children running higgledy-piggledy down a bank with the Angel (all wings) towering behind them and reaching out to save them two broken necks.

We know that our Guardian Angel is supposed to keep us from harm. But the big question is: *What is harmful?* And there is only one answer to that: SIN. Not measles, nor a broken limb, nor even death itself, for these are only bodily evils. And if we have to choose between sin and death, the issue is clear. It is better to die in the *State of Grace* than to live in sin.

When we speak of God's Providence, we mean that benign wisdom with which He governs all things. Providence wants us all to *Save our Soul*, and in bringing about that great purpose, Providence uses every means, even to permitting bodily harm to befall us.

After an airplane crash you always read of one or two people who just missed the fatal plane, and when the reporters ask them how they came to be late they sometimes say, "I don't know. It must have been my Guardian Angel."

Immediately you think of the dozens who died on the plane and you ask yourself: *Where were their Guardian Angels?*"

We have the answer already. God saw some higher purpose to be served by allowing their lives to end at that moment and in that way. Perhaps at that very instant there were some ready for death who would never again be so well prepared, while for the rest--- if they were in the state of sin, God might have foreseen that a longer life would only make them worse rather than better. But we can never fathom the depths of God's Providence

Our life is like a tapestry being woven by an expert craftsman. Looked at from the wrong side, it is full of bumps and knots and tangled threads. But if you turn it over you will see that every knot introduces a contrasting color. The gold and blue and scarlet first had to be led through the fabric, then knotted and clipped.

On earth we see life from the wrong side, so to speak. It is only in the next life that we shall see the purpose of all the bumps and knocks that seem to torment us here below. And we shall understand very clearly that God knew what He was doing all the time.
