

# BANNERS FOR FIRST EUCHARIST

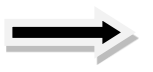
For the Liturgy celebration, each communicant makes a banner for his or her family pew. This banner is a wonderful way that you, the parent, along with your child (and other family members!) to make this a special part of the celebration! And a great keepsake too! However, let the children give the ideas and let them do most of the work.

Please follow these simple directions:

- The banner is to be **12” (width) by 16” (length)**. The size of the banner is important so that it will fit on the end of the church pew.
- The base of the banner is to be made of fabric, felt or burlap in any color desired.
- The child’s **first name only** should appear on the **FRONT** of the banner. (This can be across, down, diagonal). No family (last) names, please.
- The child may choose any **appropriate symbol(s)** for the banner. Appropriate symbols include: bread, wheat, cup, plate, person, scripture, etc. These symbols can be made with material and trimmings.
- Words may be used on the banner but it is not necessary.
- The banner should **come from the child**, noting special parts/symbols of First Eucharist.
- Banners need to be attached to a **14” rod or wooden dowel** with a string or ribbon so that they can be hung from the pew.
