

## Good Shepherd Parish Council Meeting

March 26, 2019

1. January 2019 Parish Council meeting minutes and Financial Reports were approved. Fr. Chuck noted that we're on pace to meet Collections budget. Also, the parish Benevolence fund is doing very well, but not receiving many aid requests.
2. Erma shared notes on the recent Pastoral Change Meeting with representatives from the five parishes in our cluster, Dr. Reynolds and Father Shooner from the Archdiocese. We can expect announcement of our new pastor and parish cluster changes the week after Easter.

### 3. Council/Committee Reports

Administration – Tom Knopf:

- New lighting, with drop ceilings and LED tubes, currently being installed in the offices and common areas of Lehmann Hall.
- Church - It has been decided not to proceed with the \$6,000 assessment of the roof. Dave Jewell knows a roofer who will give us another opinion.
- Fr. Chuck will follow up on repairs to the stone wall in front of rectory with GS staff.
- Good Shepherd Festival will be Sept. 7, 2019.

Community Service/ Outreach – Deloris White:

- Men's Club – Fish Fries doing great – have been selling out. Tony Ratterman has offered his band to play a future event for free, date TBD.
- Ladies of Good Shepherd Card Party raised about \$930 for the March charity and \$1,125 for the April charity.
- Catholic Charities may be moving the Common Table from St. Anthony to Dare to Care facility on South 28<sup>th</sup> street. Not sure yet how this will effect Table of Plenty.
- Community Easter Egg Hunt will be April 20th at Good Shepherd campus.
- An outing to Derby Dinner Playhouse is being planned.
- On April 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:30P, Community Catholic will host a performance by the Sacred Heart School Choir at Good Shepherd Church. Event is free and open to public.

Worship – Nina Hudelson

- Fr. Chuck reported that Kyle Legg will come into the church at Easter Vigil. He has completed rite of election and this Sunday will complete scrutiny at 11A mass.
- Worship committee purged/organized articles in the choir loft and behind the altar.
