### Dress Up Oral Book Report

On Thursday <sup>Feb.</sup> ~~March~~ 20, 2014, we will be presenting oral book reports. The students need to choose a biography or autobiography for this book report. Each student is expected to follow the guidelines listed below. Each will be worth 10 points:

1. Start with a fun, exciting introduction to the book. One that will catch our attention!
2. Tell us the title and author of the book.
3. Tell us who the book is about, *but don't tell us the ending of the story*. You want to make us interested and want to read the book!!
4. Describe the main characters of the book, and explain why you chose that character to dress like.
5. Listen and be respectful of all presentations!

\*\* YOU WILL RECEIVE 40 POINTS FOR DRESSING UP AS A CHARACTER FROM THE STORY! Use props to help add to your character! For a TOTAL OF 100 POINTS!

**\*Additional information and tips for the oral book reports\***

1. Students may jot down helpful information on 3x5 cards.
  - \*introduction
  - \*title and author
  - \*what is the book about?
  - \*describe the important characters and why you chose to dress like that character.
