



Worship Notes for the following Weekends:

Oct 16, Nov 21, Dec 19 2021 and Jan. 23, Feb. 13, Mar 27 , Apr 24 2022

Mass is the single most profound encounter with God you can have on earth. Jesus is present at every Mass. As a Catholic seeking the Sacrament of Confirmation you are required to attend Mass every weekend and especially during the Christmas and Easter Seasons.

You will have a specific assignment each Sunday there is a Confirmation Session. **For each of those Masses you will complete a “Worship Note” for the Mass held on the day of each Confirmation Session.**

You’ll be provided with guided reflection questions for those weeks. A completed assignment should be at least one full page, follow all the rules of English regarding spelling, grammar, capitalization and punctuation. You must write in full sentences with a subject, verb and predicate. The assignment must be double spaced (12 point print) and handed before the end of the week during which the Mass was held in order to continue to participate in the Confirmation Program.

Each of the five Worship Notes must include these five things:

1. Date of Mass
2. Name of the presiding priest spelled correctly
3. Briefly summarize the Gospel reading or homily.
4. How might the Gospel reading or homily apply to your life? And, how does the message challenge you to live differently this week?
5. What might God be trying to reveal to you through His Word in this Mass?
