

Public Masses Resume

We will be following strict safety measures including limiting congregants to 25% of the fire code capacity with proper social distancing between families/individuals. We will have the social hall set up with a live-stream if more seating is needed to maintain the protocols. All protocols can be read below in the "Messages from the Diocesan Administrator." Please note, that no one is obligated to attend Mass at this time; however, Sundays are still to be set apart as Holy.

Safety Protocols

**For the RESPECT & PROTECTION of others
in accord with the MN Bishops,
we ask you to, please, comply with the following:**

- Respect physical distancing of six feet.
- Tape in the center aisle marks 6 feet for the communion line.
- Hand washing and hand sanitizing are expected.
Sanitizer is available at the church entrances.
- Wearing masks is required by state mandate with few exemptions: those 5 years of age and under, individuals with a medical or mental health condition, or individuals with a disability that makes it unreasonable for the person to maintain a face covering. Masks are located at each entrance for those who don't have a mask. Please take one and keep for your own use.
- No congregational singing at this time.
- Please sit in open pews only. (1/3 of the pews are roped off for ease of sanitizing and spacing.)
- Missalettes are at the church entrance. Please to bring back and forth for Mass, do not return to the pile.

Pews, door handles, and bathrooms are being sanitized regularly according to CDC recommendations.
