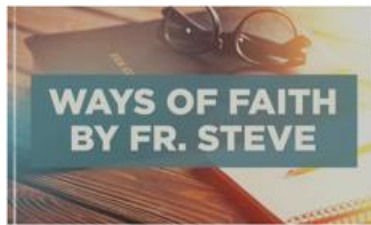


Good Evening!

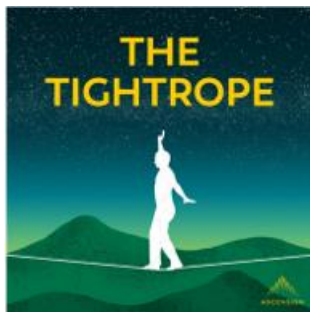
